














BEST PRACTICES FOR CLEANING PLAYGROUND EQUIPMENT

IMPORTANCE OF CLEANING





-  Disease control and prevention
-  Reduce risk of contamination
-  Keep your KLIMBS looking new forever

 *This is a great time to inspect your KLIMBS for damage. Treat chewed areas with chew deterrent spray. The presence of chewing marks may warrant a discussion with employees. If your employees are missing obvious inappropriate behaviors such as chewing, what subtle but more hazardous behavior issues are being missed? Chewing is an unwanted behavior which should be immediately interrupted.*

UTILIZING CLEANING PRODUCTS

-  Remove any large debris (fur, fecal matter, urine puddles)
-  Spray solution directly onto surface directly (rather than onto a towel)
-  Follow cleaning guidelines on your pet safe cleaner
 -  (ex: allow to sit on playground equipment for required length of time)
-  We recommend a deep clean with pressure washer once a month or as needed.
-  Allow to dry thoroughly
 -  (pro tip- during deep cleans use your force blow drier.)

PLACES TO PAY SPECIAL ATTENTION TO

-  Vertical surfaces dogs urine mark on
-  Leg holes
-  Connection points
-  Cracks and crevices where bacteria may get trapped
