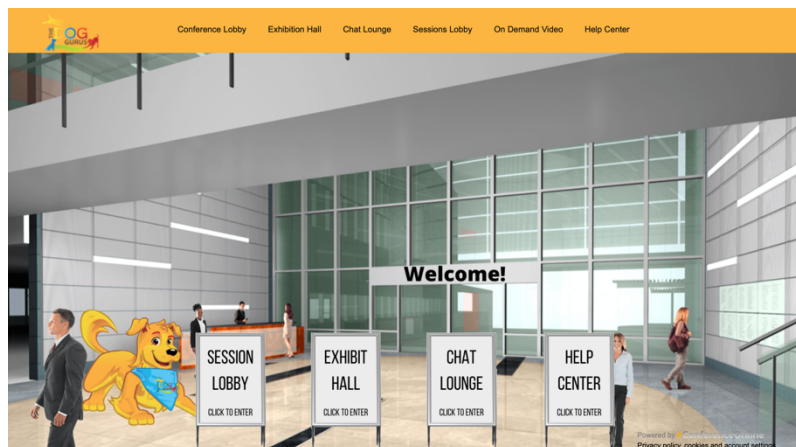
### 1. What Is It?

### 2. Do I need a Zoom or Facebook Account?

No. This is a true virtual event being conducted on **virtual conference software** by [vconferenceonline.com](http://vconferenceonline.com). You don't need anything special other than a computer, tablet or iphone and an internet connection. You'll be able to log in and **view all the presentations conducted at the live event**. We have 5 different tracks from our 5 educational partners and you can select from the entire schedule what sessions you want to see. When you login you will see the lobby below. ### **3. How long to I have to watch everything?**

### **4. How much does it cost?**
